Scale of 1 (very poor) to 3 (adequate) to 5 (exceptional):

1. Is the work well grounded in the current state-of-the-art? (well researched?)
2. Is the problem well defined?
3. What is the relative importance of the work to the field?
4. What is the technical depth of the work?
5. Is the work original and innovative?
6. Is there research potential for future work?
7. Is the work of publishable quality?
8. How well is the work validated (quality of the solution)?
9. How good is the writing?
