

## CSC 484 Questionnaire on Areas of Project Interest and Expertise

The purpose of this questionnaire is to gather some initial information on the possible composition and focus of project teams this quarter. As described in the syllabus, the projects will involve user interface design and usability.

Ideally, we should have multi-disciplinary teams for projects with these foci. Since such teams are logistically difficult to assemble in an academic environment, we may want to compose teams with class members who have differing areas of interest and domain expertise. To this end, please answer the following questions.

Note that diverse team membership is *not* a requirement for 484. You may choose to have a homogeneous team composition. This questionnaire is for information gathering purposes.

2. In what non-CS/SE areas do you consider yourself a potential domain expert?

The preceding questions relate to areas of expertise potentially germane to project team membership. The following questions relate to possible project topics.
