

Connecting to Vogon from a Mac

1. For file transfers to/from Vogon:

- a. Download and install Cyberduck (www.cyberduck.ch) or another FTP client.
- b. Open Cyberduck and click the plus symbol in the bottom left corner.
- c. From the dropdown list at the top, select “SFTP (SSH File Transfer Protocol)”
- d. Fill in the required fields:
 - i. Nickname: A nickname for this connection.
 - ii. Server: `vogon.csc.calpoly.edu`
 - iii. Port: 22
 - iv. Username: *Your calpoly username*
 - v. Path: `/home/<your_username>`
- e. Close this window.
- f. Double click the new connection you created. You will be prompted for your password.
- g. You can transfer files by dragging and dropping into the new window that opens.

2. Connecting to Vogon through the command line:

- a. Open Terminal.app (Applications>Utilities>Terminal)
- b. Type: `ssh your_username@vogon.csc.calpoly.edu`
- c. Press return. You will be prompted for your password. When you enter your password, nothing will appear on the screen; don't worry, this is normal. Just enter your password and press Return when done.
- d. Accept any RSA keys. You may now navigate the commandline as you did in Lab 1.
